Upon discovering a weathered steel drum that had been warped to resemble the sleeve of a garment, artist Gordon Chandler was inspired to embark on a series of kimono sculptures formed from found metal scraps. With an eye to the aesthetic possibilities of this humble material, Chandler invests reclaimed steel with sculptural fluidity and a wry sense of form.

A relatively simple example of Gordon Chandler's ongoing buck head series, this wall mounted sculpture titled "Yellow Stag" traces the silhouette of a male deer head in a sheet of found steel. Continued...
