The bowl's glazed interior and raised strap handles indicate it may have hung over a heat source for use as a baking dish. The jar is finished in a light green glaze in the palette of celadon ware, textured by pitted wear and a subtle crackled pattern. Today, we love this rustic kitchen vessel as a serving dish or tabletop planter.
