

This petite 19th-century earthenware bowl is cloaked in an opaque cream glaze, which drips and pools over the bowl's shallow form. The tiny bowl has a textured finish and rests on an unglazed footed base. Once used to present ritual offerings on a domestic altar, we love this small dish to catch small items with grace.
