A dark blue-black glaze coats the angular body of this squat kitchen vessel, spilling over its high shoulders with a drip-like finish. The petite early 20th-century dish was once used for storing food in a Qing-dynasty kitchen, as evidenced by its interior glaze. Dotted with imperfections, the lustrous dark glaze gives this pantry jar a glassy appearance, contrasted by the unfinished base and lip. We love this petite vessel as a tabletop planter for a succulent or a single orchid.
