Taking months or even years to create, this gorgeous carpet was painstakingly crafted by tying pieces of vegetable-dyed wool around a cotton warp in thousands upon thousands of individual knots. A true labor of love, the resulting carpet is marked by subtle imperfections that reveal the weaver's hand.

This rectangular area carpet dates to the early 20th century and features a Peking-style floral medallion-plain design. Knotted in a palette of gold, blue, and purple, the carpet is patterned with five round medallions of geometric fretwork and lotus flowers, symbols of purity and perfection. Continued...
