

Necklaced on cows or used as percussive instruments in a traditional gamelan, cowbells are still a familiar sight in remote villages of Indonesia. Carved from a single piece of wood, this bell was crafted in Lombok, an island near Bali that is renowned for its extraordinary batik textiles. We've suspended the bell from a simple metal stand to showcase its sculptural angles and the beauty of its richly burnished wood.
