

Chicago-based artist Michael Thompson creates unique kites crafted from split bamboo frames covered with stretched muslin and a collage of vintage Asian ephemera—including fragments of fabric, scrolls, drawings, and books collected during his travels. In "Pagoda on Lake," Thompson honors the practice of contrasting verdant, untamed terrains with built architectural elements. Like a lake lapping at a shore, a wash of indigo pools at the center of the kite, the flowing waters interrupted by a plane of neatly ordered calligraphy. Continued...
