Fired at the historic Chinese imperial kilns of Jingdezhen, this petite jar is adorned with two ripe pomegranates, traditional symbols of fertility and prosperity. The fruits are rendered whole, simply outlined in classic cobalt and lightly colored with a wash of pale pink.
