Embellishing with silver and gold thumbtacks, the bms. adds a contemporary twist to our storied objects, animating each surface with bold and provocative designs. This gilt tote was originally a Qing-dynasty grain bucket from Hebei province, carried by means of a burden bar resting on the shoulders.
