Once used on a provincial Chinese farm to hold water or animal feed, this early 19th-century stone trough is celebrated today for its organic form and rustic authenticity. Hand-carved from solid limestone, this rectangular trough has been carved with a shallow basin on the left side, leaving the right in its original construction. The granular surface of the stone has weathered with time, resulting in natural erosion and color variation. Continued...
