
## PAGODA RED

As if this elegant table's carved scrolling vine spandrels weren't enough evidence of its artful workmanship, look closely and you'll find gourd-shaped inlays on its beautiful tabletop. The table likely graced the study of a Qing-dynasty scholar would have used its wide expanse of richly lacquered Elmwood for spreading out painted scrolls or creating works of calligraphy. Achieving a modern-looking aesthetic centuries ago, this table's clean lines are just right for an office desk or dining table.
